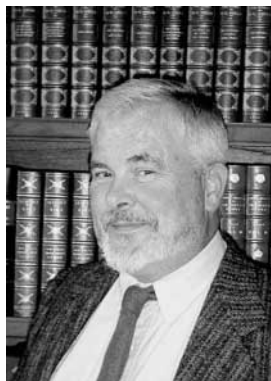

For many youths who intend to embark on a life changing overseas study experience, it is important for them to receive sound and impartial advice before choosing their study destination. Since its inception, Hui & Kuah has been providing stellar education counselling service to many bright young men and women who harbour dreams of travelling overseas for a chance to receive good quality education from leading foreign institutions.

The Australian education industry has benefited a great deal from the work done by education agents like Hui & Kuah. EATC is delivered online via a website - <http://www.pieronline.org/eatc/> - which contains readings, links to related resources, self assessment tasks (often in the form of case studies) and self-paced tutorial exercises including self-monitoring multiple choice questions. Education agents can access and use the training material at no cost as many times as they wish.

Education agents will continue to play an important role in the promotion of international education. Singaporeans who are heading overseas to study have become discerning shoppers of academic institutions. However, I am confident that local education agents who represent Australian institutions, like Hui & Kuah, will continue to provide professional service to those seeking information about studying in Australia.

Once again, congratulations to Hui & Kuah on reaching this important milestone in its history.
